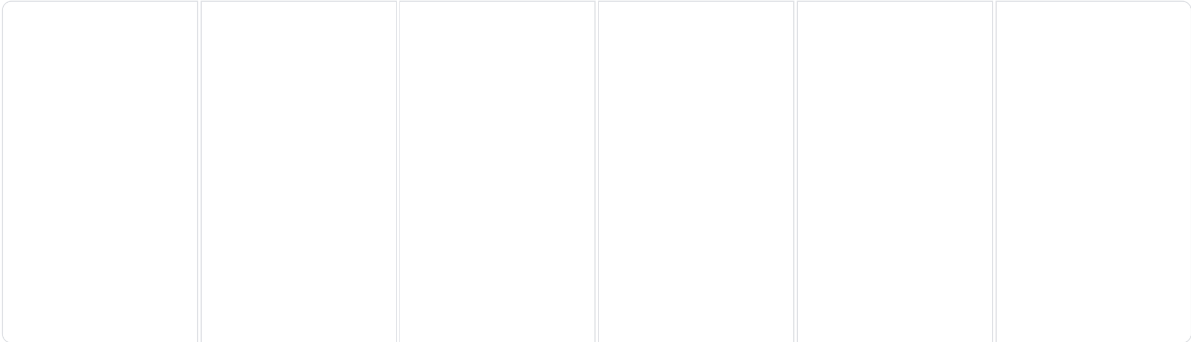




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"Education Leaders Of India", An Initiative By BeyondSkool Kick-Starts Its Mumbai Chapter With The Most Unique Principals Conference
